Calderwood Primary uniform is grey and/or navy trousers, skirts and pinafores and white or blue shirts, blouses and polo shirts. We have suppliers for Calderwood Primary embroidered sweatshirts and polo shirts, however, embroidered items are optional and not insisted upon. There are now two providers for the Calderwood Primary uniform. Parents and carers should order directly from the suppliers. This provides parents with a greater variety of choice and competitive prices.

GENERAL NOTES ON SCHOOL UNIFORM FOR PRIMARY 1

- School ties can be purchased from the school office, but P1 are given a FREE school tie as a gift from our Parent Council. You may still wish to order a spare tie. I will make these available to parents during one of our induction events. Ties cost £5 and can be purchased directly from the school office. Please try to bring in the correct money if you need to buy a tie as we only hold a very small amount of petty cash in school.
- We encourage all children to wear a shirt and tie every day to school, except when they have P.E. On P.E. days, pupils may wear their polo shirt to school.
- School shoes should be black unless pupils are wearing wellington boots in wet weather.
- Our pupils change their shoes when they come into school and go out into the playground. All pupils
 therefore require soft indoor shoes. Most children wear small black plimsolls, which can be purchased
 for a few pounds in shoe stores or most supermarkets. The black plimsolls can also be used for gym
 classes.
- Children wear their polo shirts for P.E. lessons and are required to bring a pair of shorts. **Football strips** are not acceptable for gym classes. All classes are also timetabled for outdoor P.E. and jogging trousers/leggings and long sleeved tops can be worn for these sessions.
- Grey or navy socks and tights are preferable.
