Uniform for Physical Education

We want to ensure that all pupils can enjoy P.E. at Calderwood, and that they are able to participate safely and fully in all lessons.

Indoor P.E.

For indoor P.E. sessions, our uniform is a blue polo shirt with navy shorts and trainers/gym shoes*.

*We appreciate that this may need to be adapted for some pupils for cultural reasons, which we fully support.



Outdoor P.E.

For outdoor P.E. sessions, our uniform is a blue polo shirt with navy shorts and trainers/gym shoes.

In the colder weather, pupils may also wear navy joggers/leggings and a navy hoodie.

Jewellery

For health and safety reasons, jewellery should not be worn during P.E. lessons.

If earrings cannot be removed, they should be covered with medical tape for each P.E. session. Parents/carers should provide the tape (a roll can be kept in school for your child). We would not encourage pupils to have their ears pierced during term time.



Trainers/gym shoes should be suitable for sport - no Crocs or slippers should be worn.

Skorts are not part of our P.E. kit, as they could get caught on apparatus during some activities (for example, gymnastics), however, if you have purchased skorts this year, they may be worn for this session only.

Pupils should not wear branded sportswear to school. This is not part of our uniform.
