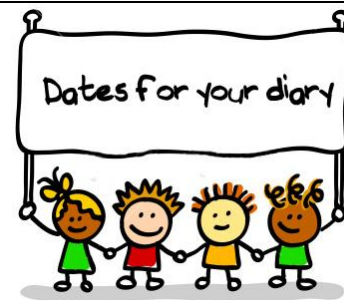

### Head Lice

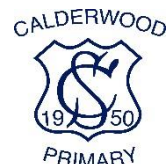
