

'Live' Google Meet Interaction with Teacher

We have prepared guidance for learners, parents and carers around the use of Google Classroom and Google Meet. We would ask that parents familiarise themselves, and their children, with the information provided which is available via the school app or our school website. We thank you in anticipation of your support with this.

Class teachers will host live Google Meet sessions with the children twice per day (am/pm) for around 10-15 minutes.

We would encourage the children to attend both sessions. However, we fully appreciate that this may be challenging for some families and would ask that time is set aside to allow the children to attend at least one of the sessions. During the 'Meet', class teachers will check-in with the children, provide pastoral support and engage in some activities such as reading a story, playing a game etc. We hope that by having this daily interaction with the teacher, the children will feel included and engaged in their learning. Please note that there will be no afternoon 'live' Meet on a Wednesday afternoon as teachers will be planning learning experiences for the children. Instead there will be a short assembly with a member of the management team.

We are aware that some families will be sharing devices and we have taken the decision to stagger live sessions to try to ensure maximum participation. Class teachers will post the code for the meeting on Google Classroom five minutes before the start of each session.
