Dear Parents and Carers,

As you may have gathered from the increasing number of letters being sent out from NHS Lanarkshire, we are once again seeing a rise in Covid cases within Calderwood. You will also be aware of the growing concern about the new variant as we enter winter.

In school, we are continuing to work very hard to ensure a safe environment for pupils and staff. We continue to follow the guidance for educational establishments provided by South Lanarkshire Council and the Scottish Government. Whilst adhering to the guidance, we are also trying to ensure a fun, active learning environment for our pupils.

We really need your help, though, to ensure that we minimise the risk of Covid spreading further within our community. Please follow the current rules around testing and isolation. These include:

- If your child displays symptoms of Covid, they should take a PCR test. Everyone in the house should isolate until the test result comes back.
- If someone in your household tests positive, everyone should have a PCR test and isolate until the results come back.
- If someone in your household tests positive, but your child's PCR is negative, they can come to school, but please remain vigilant and continue to test daily with lateral flow kits. In our experience, very often Covid will spread around families, and this can be particularly difficult to avoid with young children in the house. Please take a cautious approach.

There is no 'choice' about attending school - education is a legal entitlement and we must ensure that all our families, pupils and staff are safe.
