Lunchtimes

We will monitor the new times for a few weeks and notify you of any subsequent changes.

'Welcome Back' Pack

You will soon receive a pack of important forms to be completed and returned to the school. These include the Annual Data Check. It is essential that we hold correct contact information for each child. Please check the information we hold and update if necessary. This is particularly important regarding contacts in case of emergencies. You will also receive an EV5 (for trips/excursions) form to complete. This covers the school to take children on local outings, which you would be notified of ahead of time. A separate EV5 form would be sent home for more further afield excursions. Please send completed forms back into school as quickly as possible. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Outdoor PE Sessions

This session each class will be timetabled for one indoor and one outdoor session of PE every week to ensure that we are complying with the Scottish Government's commitment that every child experiences 2 hours of PE a week. Your child's teacher will inform you of the days for their class. Please ensure on outdoor PE days your child comes to school with appropriate clothing (i.e. joggers or leggings and a jumper). Thank you.

OUR NEW APP: Please download our new school app (see attached leaflet). This is a great way for us to keep you up-to-date with news and events and will be used to share notifications and information.


OUR WEBSITE: We will update our website regularly with important dates and upcoming events. Find us at www.calderwood-pri.s-lanark.sch.uk

PUPIL POST: We will continue to send letters home in children's school bags, please check regularly!

TEXT MESSAGE: We do have a function available to text parents, however, this is very costly to the school and can be slow and unreliable if multiple schools are using the system at the same time (for example, during snow closures). The app will replace this as a means of communication. Text messages would likely only be used for urgent messages or where other methods of communication were not possible.



Educational Excursions

At Calderwood Primary School we are committed to offering each class an excursion every school year linked to their class learning. We are also committed to offering these at no cost to parents, which we are able to do due to the fantastic fundraising efforts of our Parent Council and the support of our wider parent body. Excursions are planned along with learning at the beginning of the session, and we aim to give children fun experiences which bring their learning to life.

Absence Procedures

Please phone the office **before 9.30am** to inform us if your child will be absent from school. A message can be left on the answering machine. Please also let the office know about any medical or dental appointments by letter or e-mail. Please remember that all holidays taken during term time will be categorised as unauthorised.



School Uniform

I am delighted to see everyone back at school looking very smart in their school uniform. Just a reminder that shirts and ties should be worn every day, with polo shirts permissible on PE days.

Please remember to ensure that all children have indoor shoes to change into when they come into school. Please ensure that all items of clothing and additional items such as packed lunch boxes and water bottles have children's names on them. It makes it much easier for us to reunite lost items with their owners!



Water and Snacks

We encourage children to bring a bottle of plain water with them to school every day. A sports cap bottle is best as this prevents spillages. Please ensure that your child's name is on their bottle. This can be filled throughout the day as required.

As we are a Health Promoting School, children are encouraged to bring a healthy snack with them to enjoy at break time. Please remember that Calderwood Primary is a Nut Free Zone. We ask that children do not have any products containing nuts within their snacks or lunch boxes. Thank you.



Milk and Lunchtime Drinks

Milk is available to purchase from the school each day for a cost of 20p per carton. Water is provided at lunchtimes for children, however, if your child would prefer to bring in a carton of (non-fizzy) juice to accompany their school meal, they are more than welcome to do so.



Administration of Medicines

Please contact the office and speak to a member of staff if your child requires medicine during the school day. A form must be completed by parents or carers to allow the administration of medicines at school. No medicine should be brought into the school without staff knowledge. I appreciate your support with this matter.
