Children's Absence Information






The information below should help inform you to make a decision about whether or not your child should attend school. This information is based on the latest advice from NHS Scotland (September 2020) and will be changed or amended as necessary.

Scenario 1

Your child is feeling unwell with any one of these COVID symptoms

- A new, continuous cough
- A loss of taste or smell
- A high temperature



- 2. Use the NHS Inform website to a book a COVID test and follow their guidelines (*See link below)
- 3. Contact the school immediately to let us know about their absence and test arrangements



Negative Test Result

- 1. Inform school of test result
- 2. All children can return to school

Positive Test Result


- 1. Inform school of test result
- 2. Follow NHS guidelines for isolation

Scenario 2

A member of your household is showing any one of these COVID symptoms

- A new, continuous cough
- A loss of taste or smell
- A high temperature

1. Please do not send your children to school



3. Contact the school immediately to let us know about your child's absence and test arrangements



Negative Test Result

- 1. Inform school of test result
- 2. All children can return to school

Positive Test Result

- 1. Inform school of test result
- 2. Follow NHS guidelines for isolation

Scenario 3

Your child is unwell but is **NOT** suffering from COVID symptoms



The usual school arrangements apply...

- 1. Please contact the school office to report your child's absence
- 2. Siblings should attend school as normal
- 3. Children should remain at home for 48 hours after a bout of sickness or diarrhoea
- 4. Children who have minor ailments can attend school if they feel well enough
